Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
