

Drum Clamps

Drum Clamp - Forklifts are used to handle storing, lifting and moving pallets. For facilities which handle items in drums, you should utilize an attachment to be able to move, lift and store them. There are several drum forklift accessories which you can get for all your drum storing, moving and lifting requirements. These attachments are specially designed so as to deal with drum containers - hence there is no risk of damage to the product or drum container when they are lifted, stored or moved.

Drum Positioner And Grab

The drum positioner could be utilized to load and unload drums off of racks, drum stands and vehicles. These are obtainable in three and four tine models. This attachment is fully automatic, hence allowing the individual operating it to operate all from the comfort of the forklift seat. Able to move steel, large and extra large plastic drums, its capacity is 210 liters. This particular attachment is designed for drum pyramid stacking.

The drum grab could be mounted to the forks, with a designed objective of handling metal drums that have rolling hoops. Although the initial purpose for the design was to deal with steel drums with rolling hoops, the drum grab could help accommodate plastic drums also. Drum capacity maximum is 220 liters for plastic barrels and 210 for steel drums with rolling hoops.

The Rotator

The drum rotator is another lift truck attachment which mounts onto the forks themselves. Their purpose is to be able to lift the drum and turn it upside down. The drum is clasped into the drum rotator utilizing a clamp which fits around the middle of the drum. The rotation is performed by either a crank handle or a continuous loop chain. The crank handle is used for operations which take place below shoulder level. For operations which should take place above shoulder level, the continual loop chain will be used.

Drum tines are simple fork mounted attachment which could be utilized for stacking and unstacking 210-liter steel drums. Stacking involves nothing intricate, merely easy horizontal positioning of the drums. The carriage-mounted enhancements decrease the load center of the drums.

Automatic Tongs

Drum tongs are accessible both automatic and semi-automatic models which can be utilized in the tight head and open topped metal drum kinds. The drum tongs can likewise be connected in many various ways to the forklift. One way is to attach them underneath a fork-mounted hook. One more way is to attach them to a carriage mounted jib or a fork-mounted jib. Either the automatic and semi-automatic have a drum capacity of 210 liters. With the automatic, there is no need for the person operating it to ever leave the seat of the forklift.

Rim Grip Handler

When drums need storage with inadequate area obtainable, the Rim Grip Drum Handler is the ideal option in drum forklift attachments. This particular accessory would work for both the 210 L drums along with 120 L drums. The Rim Grip Handler operates by using steel jaws to be able to hold the edge of the drum. It lifts the drum and puts it down without requiring any room between all of the drums. The average unit utilized in the trade is a zinc-plated handler, although, this accessory comes accessible in stainless steel for the food and drink industry.
